#### General Information

- Only students who have been nominated for admission to the exchange program at the College of Management, National Taiwan University by their home schools are considered for acceptance.
- All applications should be sent collectively via your home school's international office by post to the Office of International
  Affairs at NTU CoM before the deadlines.

#### **Required Documents**

The following documents should be submitted for application:

- Completed "Exchange Program Application Form" signed and approved by the exchange program coordinator at your home school.
- Three (3) Passport-Sized Photos (for student ID card and student information database)
- ♦ One (1) Official Transcript of Academic Records
- ♦ One (1) Copy of Your Curriculum Vitae
- Photocopy of Passport Page showing name and date of birth
- ♦ NTU International Students General Health Exam Form (Form I)
- NTU International Students General Health Check List (Form II)
   (All new students must receive a health exam by a qualified physician. Health Exam Form must be submitted prior to the Registration day.)
- Copy of Health and Accident Insurance Documents
   (All prospective exchange students must show proof of insurance along with their applications. Exchange students are advised to purchase insurance in their home countries before they come to NTU.)

#### **Application Form Instructions**

#### 1. Personal Information

- ◆ Full Name in English: As shown on your passport.
- Full Name in Chinese: A Chinese name is required for registration (the name will appear on your student ID), your Chinese name should remain consistent once chosen.

If you already have a Chinese name, please put down your Chinese name.

If you do not have a Chinese name and would like to accept a given Chinese name based on the pronunciation of your original name, please tick "accept a given Chinese name" on the application form.

• Nationality: Please list all the countries of which you hold citizenship.

The College of Management, National Taiwan University does NOT accept students with Taiwanese or Chinese nationalities for the exchange program. Please note: dual-citizenship holders are NOT restricted by this regulation; a photocopy of a non-Taiwanese / non-Chinese passport is required for application.

### 2. Contact Information

Please provide your current contact information and keep us informed in the future should any changes in your contact information occur.

#### 3. Emergency Contact

Please provide the information of a person who should be contacted in case of an emergency.

#### 4. Home School Information

Please complete all required details of your home school.

#### 5. Proposed Study Program at NTU CoM

Level of Study: Must correspond with your level of study at your home school.

Period of Study: Please tick one item only as appropriate.

#### 6. Chinese Language Course

Students wishing to attend the Chinese language course can apply by indicating their willingness to participate on the application forms. The options are as listed below:

#### Choice A (for beginners only)

Course Load: 3 hours per week (one evening per week)

Equivalent to 3 NTU Credits, offered by the College of Management, National Taiwan University.

Costs: Free of charge, fees covered by the College of Management, National Taiwan University.

#### Choice B (all levels available)

Course Load: 6 hours per week (two or three evenings per week)

Equivalent to 6 NTU Credits, offered by the Chinese Language Center, National Taiwan University.

Costs: NT\$18,000 (approximately USD 550 / Euro 380), to be paid upon registration at Chinese Language Division.

#### 7. Accommodation

There are two on-campus accommodation options available for exchange students, including the Prince House - Chang Hsin Dormitory and the International Youth Center (IYC). Please be advised:

- ♦ The university cannot guarantee your choice of room type or location.
- Choices of residence, in order of preference, should be indicated by you on your application form; however, the university cannot guarantee you will be allocated your most preferred choice.
- NTU on-campus accommodations are in high demand and options are limited.
- ♦ Students who apply for on-campus housing must remain flexible with their housing choices.

Prince House - Chang Hsin Dormitory is a cooperation project between NTU and Prince Corporation.


- ◆ Prince House Chang Hsin Dormitory: Building A for male students, Building B for female students.
